- RE: ANNUAL AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER DATA CALL FILING REQUIREMENT

Pursuant to the Official Code of Georgia Annotated (O.C.G.A.) § 33-24-59.10, every "accident and sickness insurance benefits plan, policy, or contract," as defined by O.C.G.A. § 33-24-59.1 (Health Plan) and not otherwise exempt per O.C.G.A. § 33-24-59.10(e), that is issued or renewed in Georgia on or after July 1, 2015 shall provide treatment for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). The Georgia Office of the Commissioner of Insurance (OCI) is required to report information regarding mandated ASD services to the General Assembly annually. The annual due date of that report is June 15.

Accordingly, the Commissioner of Insurance directs insurers to whom this statute applies to submit the requested data for the prior calendar year to the OCI by May 15th annually.
