RE: EMERGENCY DISASTER ADJUSTER REQUESTS

On July 6, Governor Brian Kemp issued [a State of Emergency](#) for a number of Georgia counties due to potential effects caused by Tropical Storm Elsa.

In the event of a declared disaster or catastrophe, an insurer, or employer who is a licensed adjuster in this state, or is a regular employer of insurance adjusters in this state may request emergency disaster adjuster status for Georgia Registered Staff Adjusters, Out-of-State Staff Adjusters, or Out-of-State Licensees.

Insurers and adjusters should view the previously released [BULLETIN 21-EX-6](#) for instructions on requesting emergency disaster adjuster status from our office.
