RE: PREPARATION OF LARGE VOLUME OF CLAIMS DUE TO HURRICANE

DORIAN

Hurricane Dorian is now moving northeast away from Georgia along the southeastern coast of the United States. Though damage to property is not on the level of severity as what we have seen in recent years after a storm, Georgia Insurers are still under an obligation to continue to promptly identify, evaluate, and resolve each claim pursuant to the Georgia Unfair Claims Settlement Practices Act (O.C.G.A. §33-6-30 et seq.)

Insurers must still promptly acknowledge receipt of each claim and make appropriate assignments for its investigation. Policyholders should continue to receive the timely service that they expect and should not experience delays in receiving the benefits that they deserve based on the volume of claims filed with a particular insurer.
