



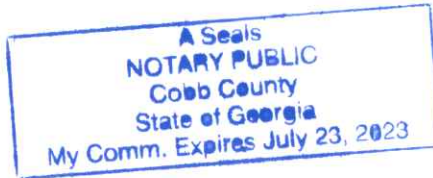

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT RULE CHANGES
AND NOTICE OF HEARING**

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to the Georgia Administrative Procedure Act, O.C.G.A. Sections 50-13-3, 50-13-4, 50-13-6, 50-13-21, and pursuant to O.C.G.A. Section 8-2-104, of the following proposal by the Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner ("the Commissioner") to amend the Rules and Regulations of the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance and Safety Fire.

The Rules and Regulations of the Commissioner of Insurance and Safety Fire are proposed to be amended by the following actions:

-Repealing Chapter 120-3-25, entitled "Rules and Regulations for Escalators and Elevators," and in lieu thereof, adopting a new Chapter 120-3-25, entitled "Rules and Regulations for Escalators and Elevators."

**SYNOPSIS AND EXPLANATION OF PROPOSED
RULE CHANGES**

These rules and regulations of the Commissioner are promulgated to establish the State's minimum safety standards and codes for escalators and elevators, as specified in the Official Code of Georgia Annotated (O.C.G.A.) Sections 8-2-100 through 8-2-109.1.

A primary purpose of these rules and regulations is to establish the state minimum safety standards and requirements for the prevention of loss of life, injury and structural damage in all buildings, structures, and other locations governed by the provisions of O.C.G.A. Title 8 and applicable regulations.

SCHEDULE

The aforesaid proposal is now on file in the Administrative Procedure Division of this office in Suite 708, West Tower, Floyd Building, Two Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, Atlanta, Georgia 30334, and is hereby declared to be a public record as follows:

Oral presentations at the hearing may be limited to five (5) minutes per person in order to afford all interested persons an opportunity to be heard. If you have a physical impairment and require assistance or have any questions regarding this notice, please contact the Administrative Procedure Division.

Based upon full consideration of all written and oral comments regarding the above matters, the Commissioner of Insurance and Safety Fire may reject

or adopt the proposed rules or make changes to the proposed rules which may require another rulemaking hearing.
