The National Board of Boiler and Pressure Vessel Inspectors has developed a series of online training courses covering the installation of six different types of pressure equipment:

Automatically-Fired Burners

Heating Boilers

Potable Water Heaters

Power Boilers

Pressure Reducing Stations

Pressure Vessels

The first two sessions of each course review regulations, laws, and standards every installer should be familiar with regarding the installation of pressure equipment.

The following sessions focus on the specific type of equipment being installed, with an emphasis on *National Board Inspection Code, Part 1, Installation*, and related *ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code Sections*.

Each of these “mini courses” can be completed in just a few hours, and although having the related reference materials is always helpful, it is not required to complete the training.

At the completion of each course a *Certificate of Completion* is issued to the student. This certificate may be printed or saved for later reference.

The State of Georgia, Office of Insurance and Safety Fire, State Fire Marshal's Office, highly recommends this series of online training courses for companies who hold Class I, Class II, and Class III Certificates of Authority in the State of Georgia. This is for individuals working as engineering contractors, mechanical contractors, and plumbers, who install, service, or perform maintenance on boilers.
