1. The Basic Module is always required for Incident Types:
 - a. 100-911
2. If Incident Type = 571
 - a. Stand By: and if Aid Given or Received = codes 3 or 4, then only the information on Basic module through Block D
 - b. Aid Given or Received: report needs to be completed by the department giving aid.
 - c. The rest of the Basic Module and the other modules as applicable are optional.
3. The Department Receiving Aid is responsible for tracking and entering all of the civilian casualty information for the incident.
 - a. If aid is given (code 3 or 4), then only the information on the Basic module through block G1 (Resources) must be completed by the department giving aid unless a fire service casualty also occurs.
 - i. Then the giving department must also complete the Fire Service Casualty Module.
4. The remainder of the Basic module and any other modules associated with the incident may be optionally completed but are not required.
 - a. The information not captured by the department giving aid is captured by the department that receives aid for that incident.
 - b. The Fire Module is always required for the following Incident Types (with the exception of aid given incidents)
 - i. 110-112
 - ii. 120-138
 - iii. 161-164 (160 is not included due to being wildland fire)
 - c. The fire Module is never (ever) allowed for:
 - i. 200-911
 - d. The Fire Module is optional for the following:
 - i. 113-118
 - ii. 150-155

- e. If the Wildland Module is not used in place of the Fire Module, then the Fire Module must be completed for Incident Types:
 - i. 140-143
 - ii. 160
 - iii. 170-173
- f. The Structure Fire Module is always required for Incident Types:
 - i. 111-112 (Only structure type element is required on code 112)
 - ii. 120-123
- g. The Structure Fire Module is never allowed for Incident Types:
 - i. 130-173
- h. The Wildland Module is optional for Incident Types:
 - i. 561
 - ii. 631
 - iii. 632
- i. The Wildland Module is never allowed for Incident Types:
 - i. 100-138
 - ii. 150-155
 - iii. 161-164
 - iv. 200-555
 - v. 571-621
 - vi. 641-911
- j. If used, Arson Module is only allowed for Incident Types:
 - i. 100-173
 - ii. Fire Cause field code on the Fire Module must also be 1-International or 2-Unintentional or 5- Cause under investigation or U- Undetermined after investigation.
 - iii. If the Wildland Module is used instead, the Wildland Fire Cause must be 7-Intentional.
- k. If used, the EMS module is only allowed for Incidents Types:
 - i. 100-243
 - ii. 311

- iv. 351-381
- v. 400-431
- vi. 451
- vii. 900

I. If used, the HazMat Module is only allowed for Incident Types:

- i. 100-243
- ii. 321-324
- iii. 371
- iv. 400-431
