COBB COUNTY WOMAN ARRESTED FOR INSURANCE FRAUD

ATLANTA – On October 21, Special Agents in the Criminal Investigations Division at the Georgia Department of Insurance assisted with the arrest of Zafirah Ali-Bey, 28, of Marietta, Georgia. <u>Ali-Bey has</u> been wanted since October 8 for 3 counts of Insurance Fraud.

"Ali-Bey is accused of forging three medical receipts which she provided to GEICO in order to fraudulently receive reimbursement for \$8,081.49," said Insurance Commissioner John F. King. "She was booked into the Cobb County Jail around 7:00 A.M. on October 21 and is now out on bond."

The Cobb County Sheriff's Office is assisting the Department's Criminal Investigations Division with this investigation.

Insurance fraud is a felony punishable by imprisonment for two to ten years, or by a fine of up to \$10,000.00, or both. To report suspected insurance fraud, contact the Georgia Department of Insurance's Criminal Investigations Division at 800-656-2298. Callers can choose to remain anonymous.
