CRISP COUNTY VEHICLE FIRE RULED ARSON

ATLANTA – Investigators with the Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner's Office have determined that a 2019 vehicle fire in Crisp County was intentionally set. The fire occurred on December 27, 2019.

"The white 2020 Kia Forte was found burning in an alley in the area of 700 West 14th Avenue in Cordele. The vehicle was reported stolen out of Cordele that same day," said Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King. "If you have any information on the individual or individuals responsible, I ask that you call my Fire Investigations Unit at 1-800-282-5804."

Rewards are offered of up to \$10,000 for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of the arsonist(s). Calls are taken 24 hours a day and callers can choose to remain anonymous.

Investigators with the Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner's Office are assisting the Cordele Police Department with this investigation.
