FANNIN COUNTY FIRE RULED ARSON

ATLANTA – A fire investigator with the Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner’s Office has determined that a structure fire which occurred the morning of Saturday, September 14, in Fannin County was intentionally set.

“The home is located at 1588 Mountain View Road in McCaysville, Georgia. The 52-year-old structure suffered major damage from the blaze,” said Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King. “The home was occupied up until the day before the fire. If you have any information on who might be responsible for setting this fire, please call the Arson Hotline.”

Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King is asking anyone with knowledge about this fire to call the Arson Hotline at 1-800-282-5804. Rewards are offered of up to \$10,000 for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of the arsonist(s). Calls are taken 24 hours a day and callers can choose to remain anonymous.

The Fannin County Fire Department, Fannin County Sheriff’s Office, and agents with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives are assisting with this investigation.
