HALL COUNTY SUSPECT WANTED FOR INSURANCE FRAUD

ATLANTA – Special Agents with the Criminal Investigations Division of the Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner’s Office are currently searching for information regarding the whereabouts of Gary Stiles, 62, of Gainesville, Georgia. Stiles is wanted for one count of Insurance Fraud and one count of Forgery in the First Degree.

Stiles is accused of creating a fraudulent certificate of insurance covering Workers’ Compensation and General Liability in July 2019 while he was performing construction at a Gainesville City School.

“Insurance fraud is a very serious offense that negatively impacts all policyholders,” said Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King. **“If you have any information on the whereabouts of this individual, please call our Criminal Investigations Division at 404-463-6363.”**

Insurance fraud is a felony punishable by imprisonment for two to ten years, or by a fine of up to \$10,000.00, or both. To report suspected insurance fraud, contact the Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner’s Office at 800-656-2298. Callers can choose to remain anonymous.
