HART COUNTY FIRE RULED ARSON

Atlanta – A fire investigator with the Safety Fire Commissioner's Office has determined that a house fire in Hart County was intentionally set. The fire occurred around 6:40 A.M on Monday, July 1st.

The double-wide mobile home, located at 658 Joe Findley Road Royston, GA, suffered major damage from the blaze. The residence is 25 years old and was 1200 square feet at the time of the fire. It is believed that the fire started in the back left side of the home. It has been unoccupied for about one year.

Anyone with knowledge about this fire should call the Arson Hotline at 1-800-282-5804. Rewards are offered of up to \$10,000 for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of the arsonist(s). Calls are taken 24 hours a day and callers can choose to remain anonymous.

An Investigator with the Safety Fire Commissioner's Office assisted the Hart County Fire Department and the Hart County Sheriff's Office with this investigation.
