HART COUNTY MAN WANTED FOR ARSON

Atlanta, Georgia – On Tuesday, July 30, 2019, an arrest warrant was taken out on James Colby Chastain, 25, of Vanna, Georgia for Arson in the First Degree. The charge stems from <u>a fire that occurred on July 1, 2019</u> at 658 Joe Findley Road in Royston, Georgia.

The double-wide mobile home suffered major damage from the blaze. The residence was 25 years old and was 1200 square feet at the time of the fire. It was believed that the fire started in the back left side of the home, which has been unoccupied for about one year.

Chastain was last seen in the Vanna area, where he fled from Law Enforcement. If anyone has any information on his whereabouts, please contact the Hart County Sheriff's Office at 706-376-3114.
