LONG COUNTY FIRE RULED ARSON

ATLANTA – Fire Investigators with the Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner’s Office have determined a fire that occurred around 6:00 A.M. on Sunday, November 24, at a Long County gathering place, was intentionally set.

“The arson occurred at 258 Linda Loop in Allenhurst, Georgia. The 24’ x 68’ double-wide mobile home suffered major damages,” said Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King. “The structure is privately owned and used as a social gathering place for people in the area. It was used the night before, but was unoccupied at the time of the fire on the next morning.”

Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King is asking anyone with knowledge about this fire to call the Fire Investigations Unit at 1-800-282-5804. Rewards are offered of up to \$10,000 for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of the arsonist(s). Calls are taken 24 hours a day and callers can choose to remain anonymous.

The Long County Fire Department and Long County Sheriff’s Office are assisting with this investigation.
