MORGAN COUNTY FATAL FIRE UNDER INVESTIGATION

ATLANTA – Around 10:50 P.M on the night of September 28, the Morgan County Fire Department responded to a residential fire located at 1381 Hardman Mill in Good Hope, Georgia. When emergency personnel made their way inside the home, they discovered the body of Stacy Malcom, 57, of Good Hope.

"The home suffered extensive damage from the blaze," said Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King. "The structure was 57 years old and 2,310 square feet at the time of the fire. Right now, the cause and origin of this tragic event are still being investigated."

Investigators with the Safety Fire Commissioner's Office are assisting the Morgan County Fire Department and the Morgan County Sheriff's Office with this investigation.

In 2019, Georgia fires have claimed the lives of 62 individuals.
