MORGAN COUNTY MAN WANTED FOR ARSON

ATLANTA – On January 31, the Morgan County Grand Jury indicted Clifford Cole Walker, 30, for two counts of Arson in the First Degree and one count of Arson in the Second Degree. The charges stem from his alleged involvement in setting two fires at 1000 Blue Spring Drive in Buckhead, Georgia, on March 9, 2019.

"Walker is accused of setting fire to a pickup truck in the driveway and then setting fire to the residence on the property," said Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King. "If anyone has any information on his whereabouts, please contact our Fire Investigations Unit at 1-800-282-5804."

Commissioner King's Fire Investigations Unit is assisting the Morgan County Fire Department with this investigation.

First Degree Arson is a felony punishable by a fine of no more than \$50,000 or by a prison term between one and twenty years, or both.
