QUITMAN COUNTY VEHICLE FIRE RULED ARSON

ATLANTA – Investigators with the Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner's Office have determined that a vehicle fire in Quitman County was intentionally set. The fire occurred shortly after 11:00 P.M. on Saturday, November 23.

"The white 2008 Infiniti FX35 was found burning on the side of the road in the 200 Block of Old Fort Gaines Road in Georgetown, Georgia. The vehicle was reported stolen out of Georgetown that same day," said Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King. "If you have any information on the individual or individuals responsible, I ask that you call my Fire Investigations Unit at 1-800-282-5804."

Rewards are offered of up to \$10,000 for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of the arsonist(s). Calls are taken 24 hours a day and callers can choose to remain anonymous.

Investigators with the Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner's Office are assisting the Quitman County Fire Department and the Quitman County Sheriff's Office with this investigation.
