TALBOT COUNTY VEHICLE FIRE RULED ARSON

ATLANTA – Investigators with the Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner's Office have determined that a vehicle fire in Talbot County was intentionally set. The fire occurred shortly after 1:20 P.M. on Saturday, November 30.

"The blue 2008 Chrysler Sebring was found burning in the middle of the road at the 800 Block of St. Paul Church Road in Shiloh, Georgia. The vehicle was reported stolen out of Manchester that same day," said Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King. "If you have any information on the individual or individuals responsible, I ask that you call my Fire Investigations Unit at 1-800-282-5804."

Rewards are offered of up to \$10,000 for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of the arsonist(s). Calls are taken 24 hours a day and callers can choose to remain anonymous.

Investigators with the Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner's Office are assisting the Flint Hill Fire Department, the City of Manchester Police Department, and the Talbot County Sheriff's Office with this investigation.
