BELLVILLE FIRE RULED ARSON

ATLANTA – Commissioner John F. King's State Fire Investigations Unit announced today that a fire at 2339 U.S. Highway 280 in Evans County has been ruled an act of arson. The fire occurred around 11:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 3.

"The Claxton Fire Department arrived at the scene to find that this 59-year-old, 960-square-foot home was completely engulfed in flames," said Commissioner King. "Further investigations by our team revealed that the fire was intentionally started in a small utility room below the garage."

Commissioner King's State Fire Investigations Unit is continuing to work alongside the Claxton Fire Department, Evans County Sheriff's Office, and Evans County Fire Department on this case.
