COLBERT FIRE INTENTIONALLY SET

ATLANTA – Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King announced today that a Madison County fire was intentionally set. The fire occurred at approximately 6:22 a.m. on January 20th on Childers Road. The fire totally destroyed the 20-year-old, 2300-square-foot residence.

“The property was owned by an Atlanta resident and was being used as a weekend home,” said Commissioner King. “The owner was not home at the time of the fire. **Anyone with information about this Madison County fire is invited to call my Fire Investigations Unit at 1-800-282-5804.**”

Commissioner King’s Fire Investigations Unit is assisting the Madison County Sheriff’s Office and the Colbert and Hull Fire Departments with this investigation. In coordination with the State Fire Investigations Unit, a reward of up to \$10,000 is offered by Georgia Arson Control for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of those responsible for arson.
