ELBERT COUNTY FIRE RULED ARSON

ATLANTA – The Office of Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King announced today that a fire in Elbert County has been ruled an act of arson. The fire destroyed a mobile home at 3501 King Hall Mill Road in Bowman around 10:00 p.m. on Friday, September 11.

“The residents of this 25-year-old, 1,440-square-foot mobile home had been evicted and the power had been shut off a few days prior to the fire,” said Commissioner King. “As we continue investigating this incident, **we strongly encourage anyone with information about this fire to contact our State Fire Investigations Unit at 1-800-282-5804.**”
