ONE ARRESTED IN CONNECTION WITH MILTON FIRE

ATLANTA – Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King announced today that Erica Vosges, 30, was arrested in connection with a Fulton County fire. The suspect is being charged with Arson in the 1st Degree.

The fire occurred on December 10th, at the 26-year-old, 1322-square-foot residence located on Avensong Village Circle in Milton.

"The fire caused a large amount of damage to the second story of the home," said Commissioner King. "Our canine unit was deployed, and swiftly alerted to the presence of accelerants."
