## TWO WANTED FOR PEACH COUNTY FRAUD, FORGERY

**ATLANTA** – Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner John F. King announced today that warrants have been issued for Erline Womack, 59, and Quatisha Porter, 40, for one count of Insurance Fraud and one count of Forgery in the 1st Degree each. Both suspects are wanted in connection with a Peach County Case.

"Ms. Porter claimed to have run over the foot of Ms. Womack," said Commissioner King. "Ms. Porter then submitted fraudulent medical documents on behalf of Ms. Womack, with her knowledge, to Geico in order to receive compensation for the injury."
